





Using the Company list

You can search for a company in a couple of different ways.

1) Searching for a company by name or code

You can do a search by going to the search box (shown below) and typing in either the ASX code, the start or part of a company name.




2) Searching for a company by sector

It helps to diversify your portfolio. This means not having all your stocks in the one industry because they are more at risk to all fall at the same time. The market allocates a particular company's main activity to an industry sector. In the Challenge you can see which companies are in which sectors. To do this, under Company search go to the 'Select companies by sector' box.


Click on the arrow (1) and this will give you a drop down list of all the sectors. Select the sector you wish to view; in this example we have selected energy (2); and this will bring up all the companies in the Challenge in that sector.

Using the Company list

On the company list page you can do any of the following:



- Add a stock to your watchlist by selecting the button. Remove a stock from your watchlist by selecting the button.
- 2) If you want to buy or sell shares in a company you can select the buy or sell button and this will take you to the Place an order page
- 3) To view the details about a specific company, click on the company name, and this will take you to the Company details page.
